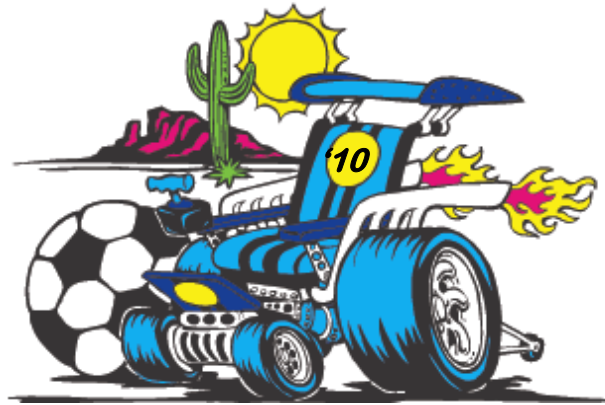

Who: Any athlete ages 6 and older with a permanent physical disability, specifically power chair users that practice with a team.

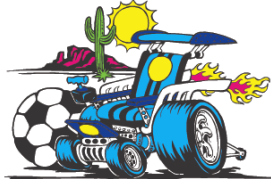
