- Annual special events including Desert Challenge Games, Arizona JV Wheelchair Basketball Tournament, PowerBlast Power Soccer Tournament and SkiAble Adaptive Alpine Experience drew hundreds of local and national athletes to Arizona.
- Sponsorship from Disabled Sports USA to host Wounded Warrior Disabled Sports Projects including SkiAble Adaptive Alpine Experience, Desert Challenge Games, cycling and kayaking allowed the organization to provide service to several veterans returning from war with physical disabilities.
- Developed new events to fund-raise and increase awareness of the organization including 1st Annual Run, Walk & Roll 5k/10k and the Bowl-A-Rama.
